These plants are going to be used to replace current plants that have died.

BUSHES:



Landscape uses for Ixora

- Low hedge
- Accent in a mixed bed
- Under low windows
- Along a walk or drive
- Front of the border planting (dwarf)
- Surrounding a palm or tree that lets sunlight through its canopy
- Lining outside of lanai
- Around the outside of the lanai or pool cage
- Foundation planting

Dwarf Red Ixora

Plant specs

Growth 2-3 FT / Spread 1-3 FT / Full to Part Sun

These plants are dependable bloomers, love the sun, and fit nicely into any size landscape.

Often planted in groups or rows for maximum color.

Clustered blooms that attract butterflies come in a variety of colors, with the texture and shape of a fat, coconut-covered cookie.

The dwarf variety has small leaves like box-wood and blossoms cover almost the entire plant.



Landscape uses for Hibiscus

- Hedge
- Accent plant by the entry or corner of house
- Anchor in planting bed
- Along a walk or drive
- Along lanai
- Privacy shrub
- To add interest along a blank wall

Hibiscus

Plant specs

Growth 4-6 FT can be kept 3ft / Spread 3 FT / Full to Part Sun

These plants are moderately salt-tolerant. They love the sun and do best (and flower the most) in full to part sun locations.

Warning: A fallen flower from one of these plants can be a foot traffic hazard - squishy and slippery. It can also stain surfaces like concrete, so keep this in mind when choosing a place to plant.

Varigated Arboricola (*schefflera arboricola, trinette*)

Plant specs

Growth 2-3 FT / Spread 2-3 FT / full sun or full shade, best in part sun or shade

It looks anywhere, next-to no care. Adds tropical flair to a ho-hum landscape. Highlight for other plants with bright yellow and green foliage. Grows at moderate pace.

Landscape uses for Varigated Arboricola

- Foundation planting
- Accent in a mixed bed
- Under low windows
- Along a walk or drive
- Surrounding a palm or tree
- Lining outside of lanai
- Around the outside of the lanai or pool cage
- In drifts to add color to a shady area



Croton (Mammy)

Plant specs

Growth 2-2 1/2 FT / Spread 1-2 FT / full sun or part shade

Slow growers, Mammy attain brightest color in full sun. May defoliate in cold winters. Good in planters.

Landscape uses for Varigated Arboricola

- Accent in a mixed bed
- Under low windows
- Along a walk or drive
- Surrounding a palm or tree
- Lining outside of lanai
- Around the outside of the lanai or pool cage
- Groundcover shrub
- Foundation plant

BUSHES:



Dwarf Podocarpus, Pringles

Plant specs

Growth 3-4 FT / Spread 4 FT / full sun or shade

Slow grower with a fine texture. Natural mounding form or can trim or sculpt bush if so desired. Deep green foliage and deeper blue-green if in shady area.

Landscape uses for Dwarf Podocarpus

- Foundation Plant
- Backdrop for smaller plants
- Low to mid height
- Along lanai, or around pool cage
- Understory planting around palms or trees
- Along walkway or driveway
- Fronting for taller plants

Hope Philodendron

Plant specs

Growth 4 FT / Spread 4 FT / full sun or shade

Versatile garden addition that sets off ho-hum landscape. Layered, ruffled greenery.

Moderate grower. Ideal tropical accent. Allow enough room between Hope and other plants so that large leaves don't overlap surrounding plants.

Landscape uses for Hope Philodendron

- Accent Plant
- Filler for garden corner
- Along lanai
- In pool cage planter
- Between palm trunks
- Under tall trees
- Container plant on lanai

Xanadu Philodendron

Plant specs

Growth 3 FT / Spread 5 FT / part sun or shade

Moderate grower. Clumping growth pattern forms attractive cushion shape.

Space 3ft apart.

Landscape uses for Hope Philodendron

- Foundation Plant
- Surrounding palms and trees
- Along lanai, walkway or driveway
- In rows in front of tall hedges
- Container plant on lanai

FERNS:



Macho Fern, giant sword fern

Plant specs

Growth 3-4 FT / Spread 4 FT / shade

A big bold fern. Makes an impressive statement. Shade lover. Spreads.

Landscape uses for Macho Fern

- Groundcover
- Foundation planting
- Surround tree base
- Camouflage for leggy plants
- Shade garden accent plant



Foxtail Fern

Plant specs

Growth 2 FT / little spread / sun or shade

Soft tufts on cold hardy plant. Spreads very little. Great accent.

Landscape uses for Foxtail Fern

- Groundcover
- Front of border accent
- Line a walkway
- Camouflage for leggy plants
- Garden accent



Wart Fern

Plant specs

Growth 1 FT / little spread / sun or shade

Lower growing fern that adds unique texture to garden. Slow growing, stays small. Spreads, but well mannered.

Landscape uses for Wart Fern

- Groundcover
- Line a walkway
- Camouflage for leggy plants
- Garden accent

Dwarf Oyster Plant

Plant specs

Growth 8 inches / Plant 1-2 ft apart / part sun or part shade

A nice, slow-spreading plant. Subtly attractive texture and color, dwarf oyster has a neat appearance in a dense bed.

Landscape uses for Dwarf Oyster

- Groundcover
- Under palms
- Border plant

Cordyline, Red Sister

Plant specs

Growth varies, approx. 5 ft/ part sun or part shade

Brilliant fuschia new growth and bronze-magenta leaves. Shows best in winter months.

Considered a good-luck plant.

Landscape uses for Cordyline, Red Sister

- Backdrop
- Tall accent plant for entry or garden bed
- Architectural accent
- Semi-privacy plant by a window or lanai
- Along a blank wall

Dracaena, Marginata

Plant specs

Growth varies, approx. 5 ft/ part sun or part shade

Nice shapeliness, fitting nicely into narrow spaces. Marginata has spiky green leaves rimmed with red.

Landscape uses for Cordyline, Red Sister

- Backdrop
- Tall accent plant for entry or garden bed
- Architectural accent by an entry
- Semi-privacy plant by a window or lanai
- Along a blank wall

Liriope

Plant specs

Growth 18 -24 inches / Plant 1-2 ft apart / sun or shade
A nice, moderate growing plant. Gets purple flower spikes.

Landscape uses for Liriope

- Groundcover
- Edging for garden or walkway
- Filler in a mixed bed
- Surrounding palms or trees
- In front of leggy plants to hide trunks



Orange or Yellow Bulbine

Plant specs

Growth 1-2 feet / Plant 1-2 ft apart / full sun or part shade
Attracts butterflies with orange or yellow flowers. Great groundcover or border plant.

Landscape uses for Bulbine

- Groundcover
- Edging for garden or walkway
- Filler in a mixed bed
- Surrounding palms or trees
- In front of leggy plants to hide trunks
