- Discussion concerning ponds.
- During current drought lawns can be mowed to the seasonal high water line.
- Ponds need root structure so the buffer is 3 feet to prevent erosion and will be trimmed 1 x per month and get no higher than a foot.
- Fertilizer will be 12 feet from the high water line.
- Replenish pump – output pump at well should be looked at to see if it is performing properly.

Connie and Michele have completed a list of homes and villas that need plant replacement.

Ginger will talk to crew to weed and pull dead plants from gardens of homes and villas.

The committee will do a walk through the community to look for trees that need trimming above the 8 foot height. Ginger and Judy will create an inventory so we can keep track of trees that are trimmed and need to be trimmed.

The back of homes 6 ft. buffer on Terracina is complete. Ginger will tell crew to keep it up so it doesn't get so overgrown.

Mulch project is complete.

Michele will get photos of plants to be added to the HOA for board approval.

Ginger created the list to include plants and trees that are for all types of conditions.

Pollination garden was discussed and the committee will get a plan and information will be presented at the next board meeting.
