

No Cut Work Orders for Artistree

Due to the constant turnover of the trimming crew, we have decided to place a small sticker on the outside of homes whose owners have decided they do not want their bushes trimmed.

Currently we have “**do not cut**” order for hibiscus bushes and bushes around pool enclosures for the development. A work order would be needed for these bushes to be trimmed.

If for any reason you want to be included in the **no trim list**, please send an email to Judy Rapaport at jcrap53@gmail.com. Even if you think you are currently on a no cut list now, please send an email confirming that to me. A sticker will then be placed on the side of your home instructing the trim crew to bypass your home. Nothing will be trimmed at your home or villa. If you have any questions please email Judy Rapaport.

You are either all trimmed or nothing trimmed except hibiscus bushes and pool enclosures which are never trimmed.

If you have a **no cut order** and decide you need trimming at your home or villa, a work order would have to be created by sending an email to Lighthouse. The work order will be completed when the trim crew is next at Verona Reserve.

Bushes on side of homes and villas should be timed to window sill height 10 times a year per Artistree contract. If a homeowner refused landscaping by Artistree for trimming bushes, the homeowner will be responsible for trimming the bushes or submit a work order to Lighthouse. If the bushes become overgrown and unsightly, The HOA will have Artistree trim bushes and billed to the homeowner.
